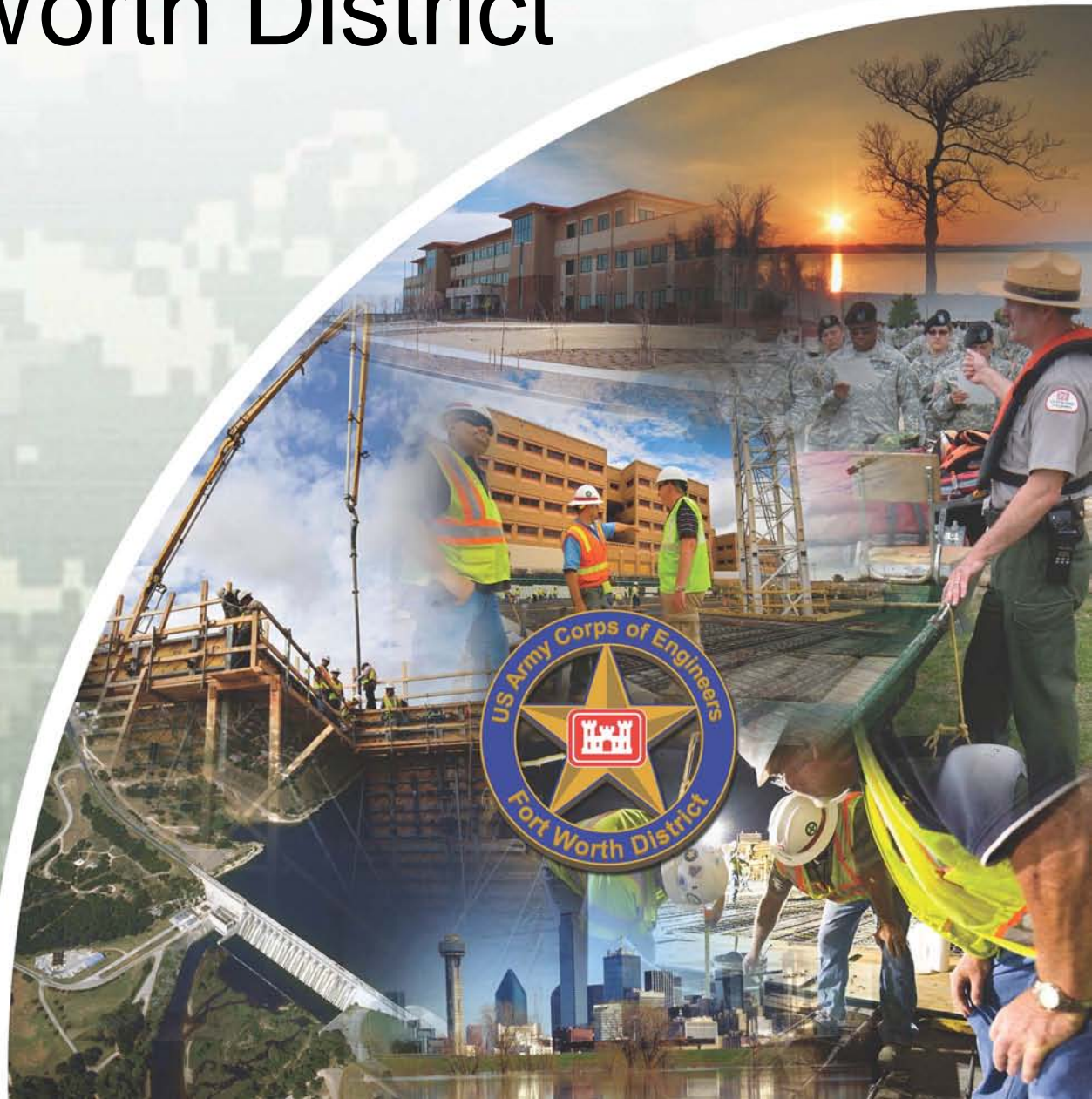

 - ▶ Regulatory program



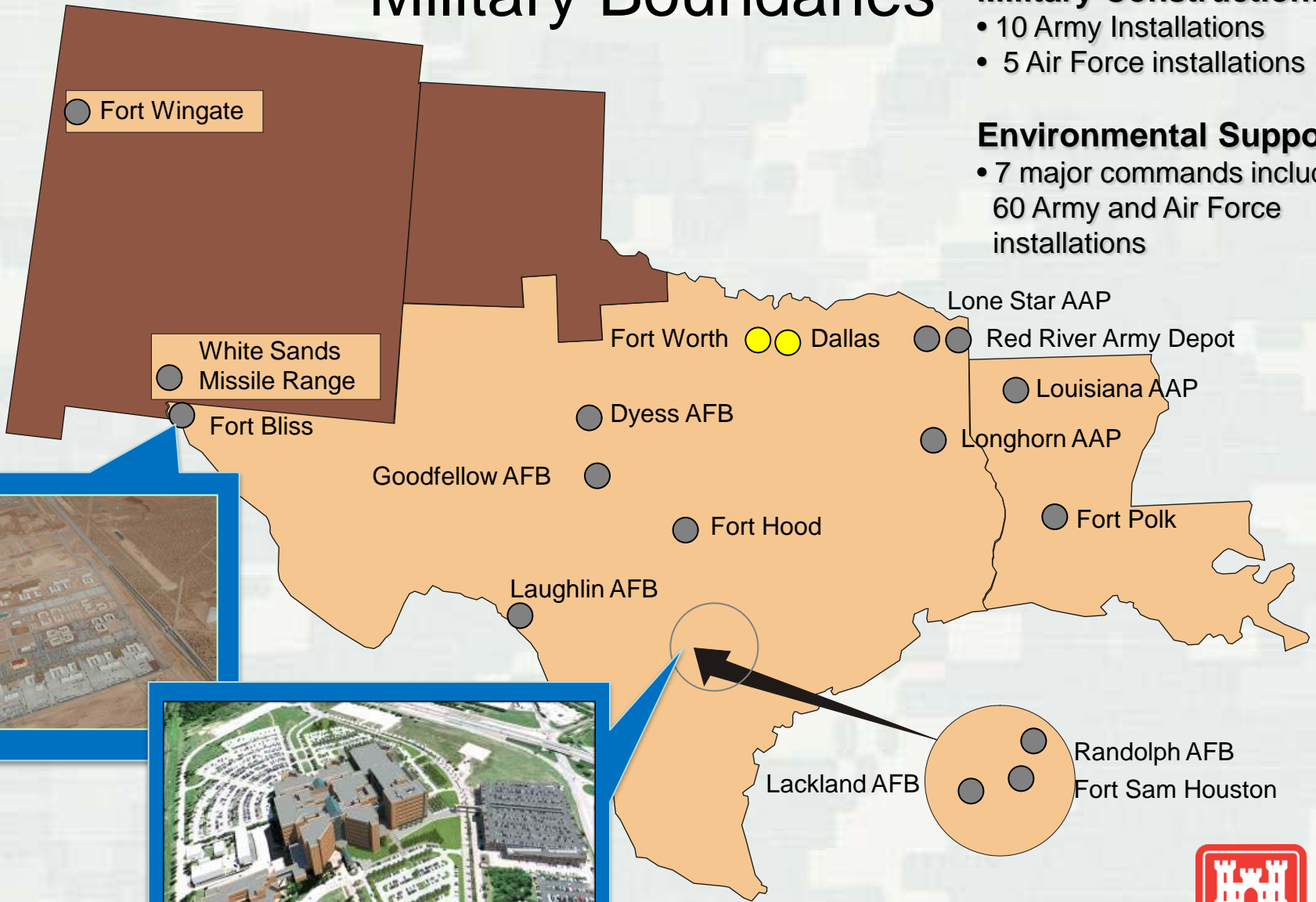
Military Boundaries

- 7 major commands including 60 Army and Air Force installations



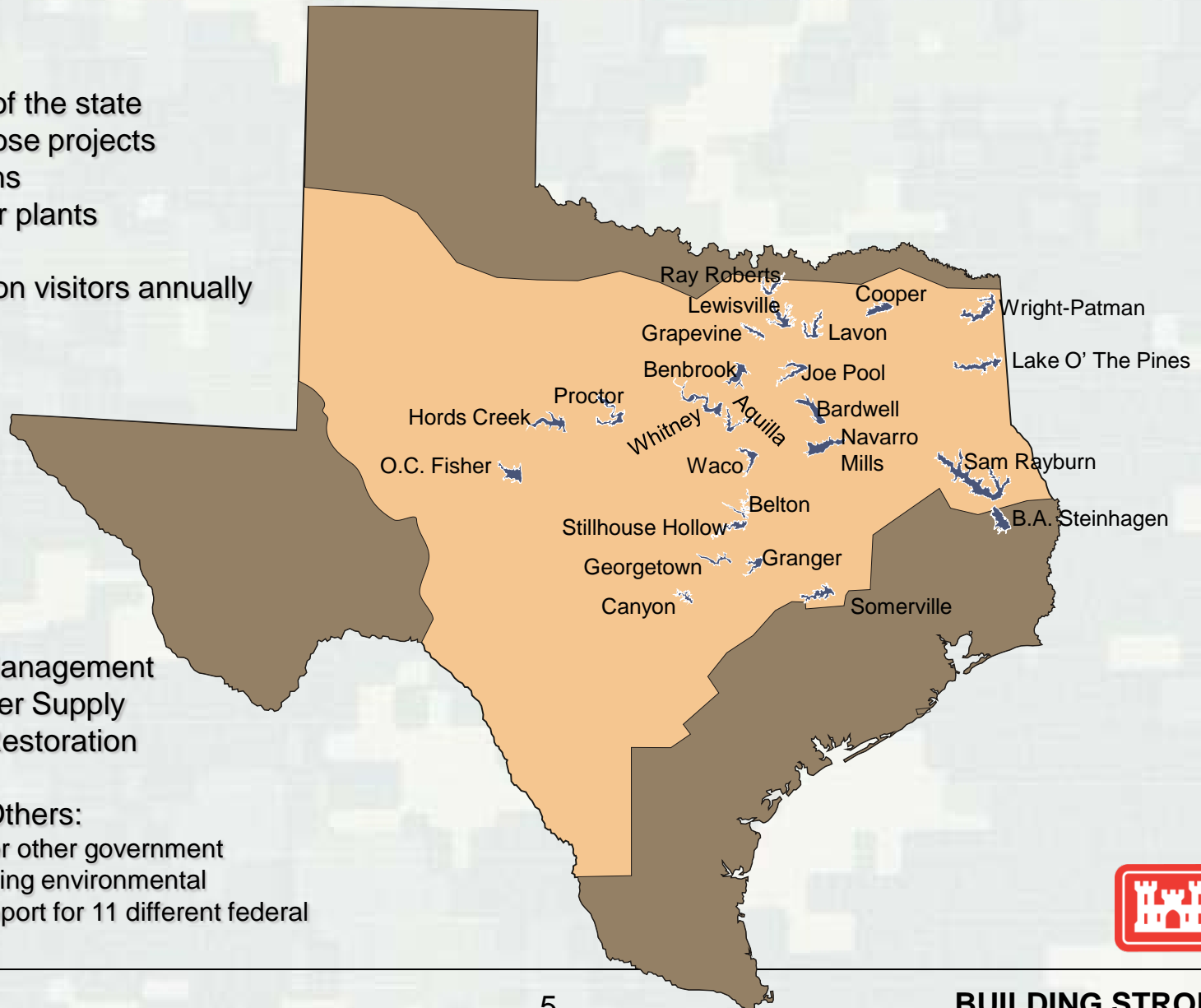
Civil Works Boundaries
