






Finally, we will have a 2009 Strategic Planning Session on November 13 - contact Loretta Turner for more information! Thanks again to everyone for another great month!

SAME New Industry Award honoring Small Business

SAME has initiated a new Industry Award honoring the work of small businesses. Two awards will be given— one for a Small Business in recognition of excellent performance as a Small Business prime contractor for USACE; and one for a Large Business in recognition of excellent performance as a contractor for USACE with Small Business sub-contracting requirements. The awards will be presented at the USACE Small Business Luncheon, Tuesday, December 9, 2008.

NOMINATIONS ARE DUE NO LATER THAN NOVEMBER 3, 2008

Small Business Award:

Eligibility:

- 1. Small business contractor for USACE in one of the listed nomination categories below:
- 2. Completion of at least one contract or task order for which USACE has provided either a performance evaluation or commendation letter;
- 3. SAME Sustaining Member for at least one full year as of July 1, 2008.

Selection Criteria:

Nominations will be judged based on the following factors

- 1. Work completed between January 2007 and September 2008 in an outstanding manner as evidenced by letters of commendation from USACE and customer;
- 2. Use of innovative technology or management to achieve outstanding results;
- 3. Company support for the professional development of its employees through participation in SAME education and training activities;
- Company participation in one or more Small Business Conferences in 2007 or 2008 (e.g., USACE Small Business Conference, Veteran-Owned Small Business Conference, a SAMEsponsored Small Business conference, etc.)

Volunteerism - Locally

- ✓ Tulsa's average volunteer rate was 33.7% between 2004 and 2006, compared with 30.3% for the entire state.
- ✓ On average, Tulsa benefited from approximately 228,000 volunteers, who served 40.6 million hours per year between 2004 and 2006.
- ✓ Tulsa is a national leader, ranking tenth in metropolitan volunteer rates and 73% volunteer retention. Tulsa-area volunteers give an average of 60 hours per year while Oklahomans, overall, volunteer an average 43.6 hours per year.
- ✓ In 2006, the estimated value of volunteer time was calculated at \$18.77 per hour. Tulsa area organizations benefited from budgetary offsets valued at more than \$762 million.
