IMPORTANT: Students must meet the following criteria to be accepted for nomination to attend this camp:

1. Completed their freshman, sophomore or junior year of high school
2. Be on a high school track that will provide a basis for attendance at an accredited engineering college or university (i.e., be taking appropriate math and science courses)
3. Have an expressed intent to pursue a degree in architecture, engineering or related field
4. Have demonstrated leadership characteristics through participation in extra-curricular, sports, and/or community activities
5. Be physically fit
6. Be of high moral character

HOW TO APPLY

1. **Download** the application form to attend the SAME/USAFA Camp in Colorado.
OR **Download** the application form to attend the SAME/U.S. Navy Seabees Camp in California.
2. **Download** the form for your doctor to sign, confirming that you are physically fit to attend camp. Have your doctor sign the form.
3. **Download** the medical treatment release form, and have your parent/guardian sign the form.
4. Obtain a **letter of recommendation** from your school counselor, or a math or science teacher, confirming that you are on a college track, are of high moral character, and have no record of disciplinary problems.
5. Submit your application, the letter of recommendation and the signed forms to Clif Warren.

The deadline for submitting application materials to the Tulsa Post is **April 15, 2004.**

Tulsa SAME Young Members are needed to be Mentors at the 2005 Engineering and Construction Camp.
