Protective Design Strategies for Petro-Chemical Facilities

This presentation will outline the tangible attractive targets available to an adversary within a petro-chemical refinery and broadly define that adversary. It will discuss the API (American Petroleum Institute) and NPRA (National Petro-Chemical and Refiners Association) five potential targeting scenarios. Protection design for Petro-Chemical facility's critical assets will be outlined as well as a discussion of worst case scenarios, prevention through design and utilization of a well planned and robustly designed security program.

He is also a Certified HAZMAT Specialist and an ALPHA™ Certified Physical Security Threat-Vulnerability Assessment Specialist.

After leaving the Coast Guard in 1998, Brook worked for 5 years at the City of San Diego and served as the City's Program Manager for Quality, Process Improvement, and Performance Excellence where he provided leadership and guidance for numerous improvement projects resulting in taxpayer savings of over \$20 million.

Brook joined Tetra Tech in 2004 as a Senior Security Specialist, in their EMI Homeland Security Consulting Group, where he is a Project Manager for assessment, planning, grant administration, training, design and implementation of emergency management and security improvement projects.

Brook has a Bachelor of Science Degree from Southern Illinois University Carbondale and a Master of Science Degree in Leadership from Troy State University Alabama. He currently serves as adjunct faculty for the National Graduate School in their practicum-based Quality Systems Management Masters Degree and Homeland Security Certificate programs.
