Craps was one of the lively games at the party. No one at the Craps table won the most chips during the festivities, but they had fun trying.

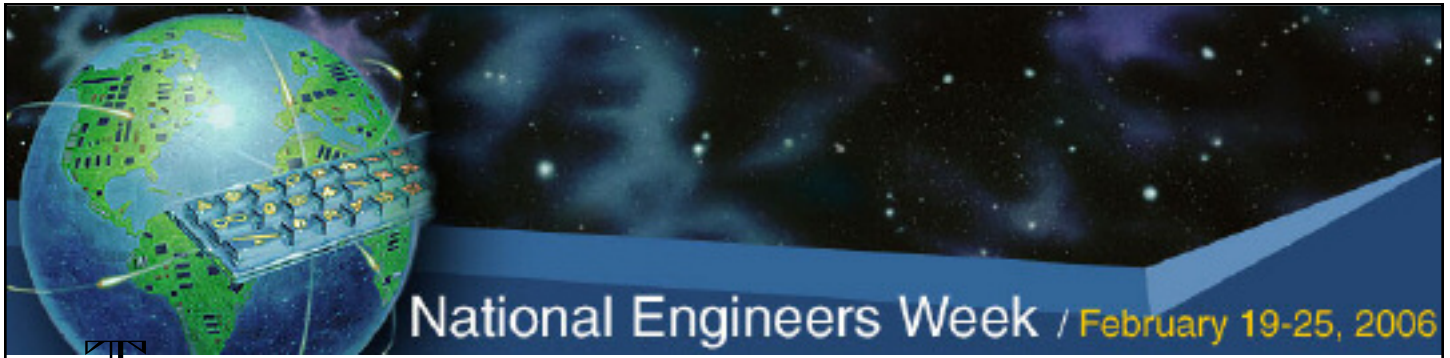
